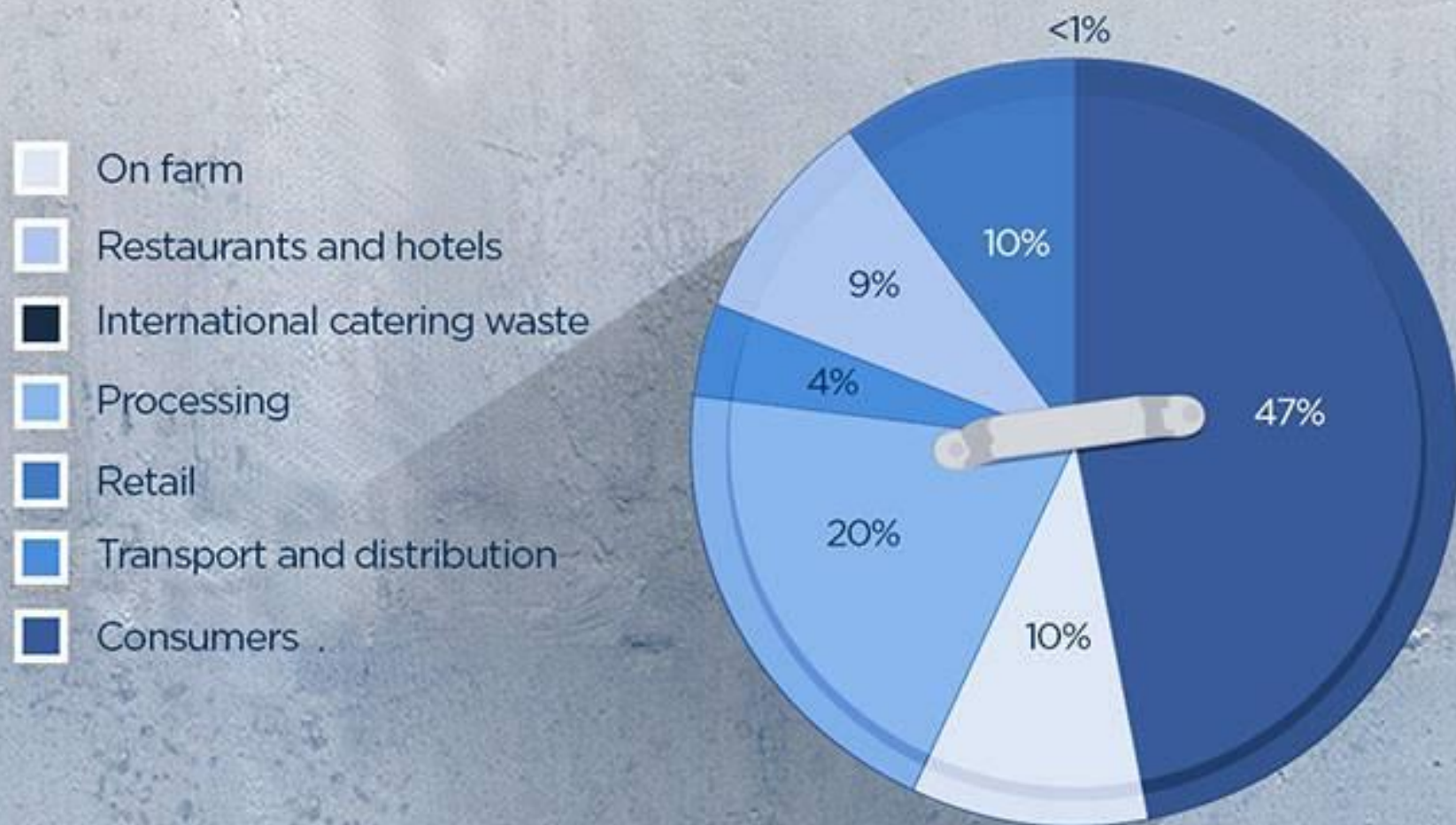
How Much We Waste Annually

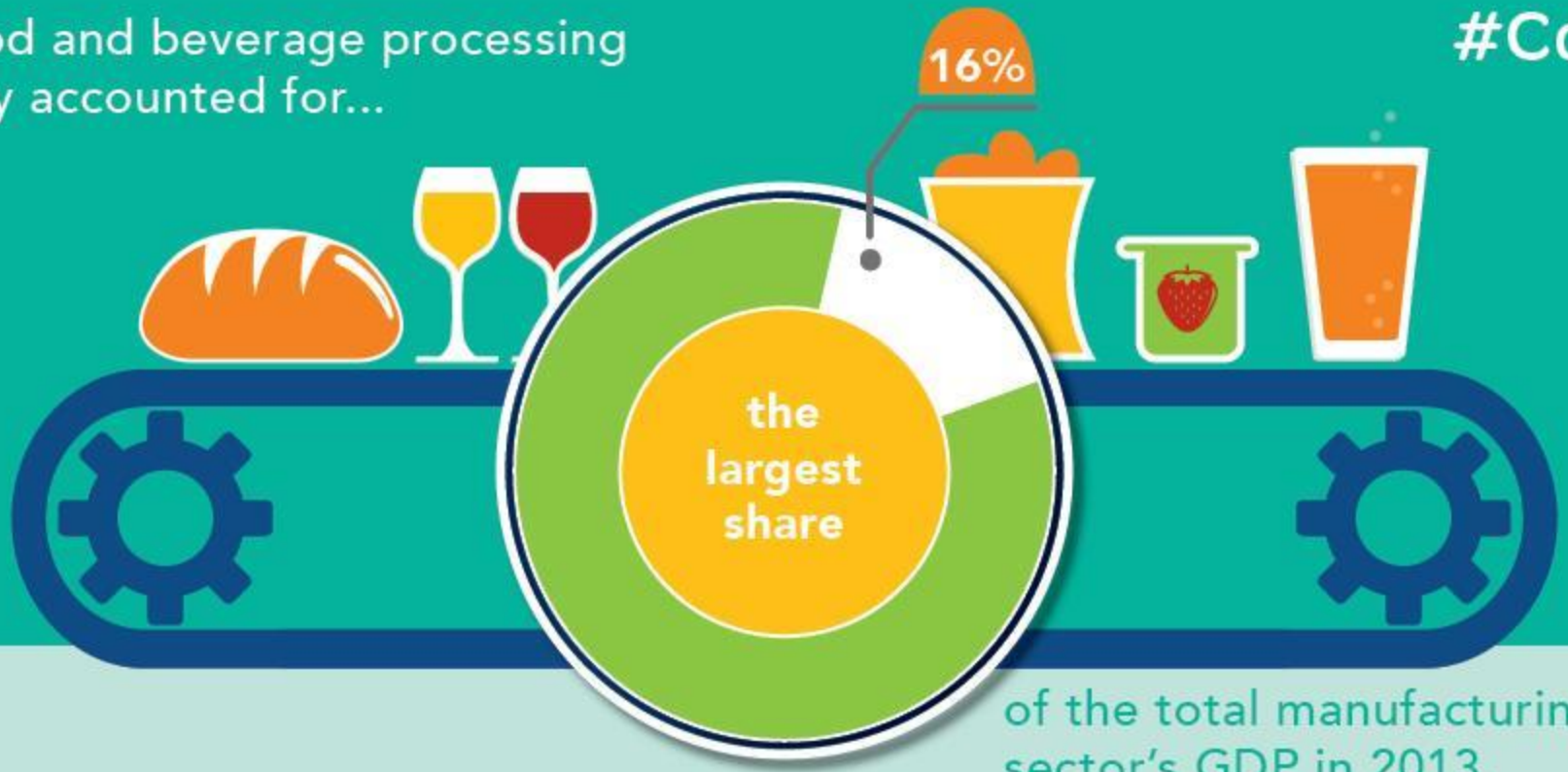
